Classes

All dancers will take a minimum of 2 classes everyday in one or more of the following disciplines:

Classical Ballet Pointe Partnering Contemporary Character Dance Pilates Mat Work Jazz

All dancers will be cast in a variety of ballets that will be rehearsed in the afternoons in preparation for several performances, small and larger, scheduled throughout the 2nd week of the Festival. A final performance will be offered on Saturday, August 14 for the entire community of Greensboro to enjoy.

Who will be teaching/directing?

Members of Greensboro Ballet's professional teaching artists and professional company members will be teaching the classes AND guest teachers will visit for one or two day residencies to give our students the opportunity to meet a variety of exceptional artists who are eager to share their personal unique insights into dance. These guest teachers include Anna-Marie Holmes, Gyula Pandi, Mate Szentes, Emery LeCrone, Jennifer Guy, and others TBA.

How do I enroll?

Students from the School of Greensboro Ballet will fill out a registration form and submit it with a \$25 registration fee. Students from other schools will need to also include 2 photos (one in first arabesque and one in tendu croise devant) along with a recommendation from their current teacher. All students will be notified within 2 weeks of receipt of application whether or not they are accepted into the program. Tuition is \$300 for the entire two week program and is payable by July 1, 2010. All checks are made payable to Greensboro Ballet. Housing with local students *may* be available for out of town students for an additional cost.
